So if .unlawful [what is] devourers of ,avid listeners to falsehood [They are] judge between them or turn away from ,[O Muhammad] ,they come to you And .never will they harm you at all - And if you turn away from them .them Allah loves those ,Indeed .judge between them with justice ,if you judge .who act justly

The Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه و سلم was sad when the people didn't believe in Allah, in spite of all the signs. Allah is consoling him not to grieve, because these people listen to falsehood, and eat unlawful things, which also includes acquiring unlawful wealth.

Despite the fact that these people were disbelievers, they still came to the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه و سلم to settle their disputes. In that situation, it was difficult to accommodate them.

Allah gave two options in these circumstances; judge between them, or turn away from them. Even if he took the option of turning away from them, they would not be able to harm him in any way.

If he took the option of judging them, then he must do it with justice, even though they were enemies.

Allah then gives the encouragement:

Allah loves the ones who remove the injustice.

then make settlement ,And if two factions among the believers should fight then fight against ,But if one of them oppresses the other .between the two And if it . the one that oppresses until it returns to the ordinance of Allah .then make settlement between them in justice and act justly ,returns .Allah loves those who act justly ,Indeed

Two groups from the believers, fighting amongst each other, need to have someone to make peace between them. If one group still transgresses, they must be fought with until they return to Allah. Now is the time to be just with the group which transgressed, because it is easy to be irritated with them. The test is to be neutral, and judge between them with justice.

Allah does not forbid you from those who do not fight you because of from being righteous - religion and do not expel you from your homes Allah loves those who ,Indeed .toward them and acting justly toward them .act justly

This verse is about the Muslims who have relatives who are disbelievers, they have to be dealt with in justice. Allah has not forbidden justice from those disbelievers who don't actively oppose Islam.

This is not an easy matter, so again Allah gives His slaves motivation by saying He loves the Muqsiteen.

They are just with people around them, and they work with truth and justice. They don't oppress anyone, give everyone their rights.

They do good to those who do good to them, by showing their gratitude, supplicating for them, appreciating them.
