### The Manners of the Carrier of the Qura'an

Imagine the one who recited the Qura'an in dunya. On the Day of Judgement, he will be told to recite. It will be a day of celebration, the test will be over.

The one attached to the Qura'an will be told in front of everyone, to recite in slow and measured tones, like he recited in dunya.

The recall of the ayaat will depend on how much they sink into the heart. It is very important to ponder upon the Qura'an, to feel them, and to act upon them. Allah will make him recite, not by his memory, but from the heart.

Jannah has levels, according to the quality of your worship. The difference in each level of Jannah is like the heavens and the earth. With each ayah that you learn, the state of your heart should be better.

The Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه و سلم said :

If anyone recites the Qur'an and teaches it, and acts according to its content, on the Day of Judgement his parents will be given to wear a crown whose light is like the light of the sun. And they will be clothed in a garment the likes of which is not found in dunya. It will

To act upon the Qura'an means that your heart moves, feeling the love, hope and fear. When you are reciting the Qura'an, and acting upon it, you are doing بر الوالدين , because they will be rewarded for it on the Day of Judgement.

In dunya, usually in intellectual competitions, we see people getting medals and other prizes. So the parents of the reciter of the Qura'an will be crowned as an honour for being the parents of a righteous child. This is another reason why we ask for righteous offspring.

If this is the reward for the parents, imagine what the reward for the person reciting the Qura'an, and acting upon it, will be!

Allah sometimes mentions the delights of Jannah in an indirect manner, by hinting at the luxuries. Allah mentioned the lining of

the couches in Jannah as being the best silk, so what about the exterior?

When your heart feels and moves, all the limbs will follow.

Recite the Qura'an, don't stop, even if you can't feel it. The ayaat will eventually go to your heart, so don't give up. Be aware of the shaitan, he will always make you feel disappointed and sad. Allah will reward you for every letter.

There are stages of understanding. Allah will not punish the person who has the Qura'an in his heart. Allah will save you because of the Qura'an.

The Qura'an is a feast from Allah, and it is open for everyone. It appears so difficult, and the first time you approach a circle of knowledge, you are hesitant. But once you enter, it's like a feast, with different varieties of food. The one who doesn't taste the sweetness of the Qura'an is the loser.
